The Beaujolais Villages are located on the northern part of the vineyard and are spread over 38 villages. The steep vines, facing south / south-east between 200 and 500 meters above sea level, surround the 10 Beaujolais crus.

Intimate cuvée by its surface, we appreciate them in their youth. Beaujolais Villages Blancs are wines for pleasure and celebration: emblem of our Beaujolais Terroir where sharing and conviviality reign in the cellars. Average altitude: 332 meters Cultivation area: ha.
