Appellation

Viré Clessé is the first Village appellation resulting from remarkable terroirs in the Mâcon Villages area.

Viré and Clessé are two towns in southern Burgundy, between Tournus and Mâcon. The Monts du Mâconnais form an area favorable to the vine. Recognized AOP in 1998 Cultivation area : ha.

Grapes picked at full maturity

Harvested by hand exclusively Terroir of sandstone pebbles and limestone soils Manual pruning Grape variety 100% Chardonnay



Vintages & Tasting

Shiny pale gold color

Nose offering a bouquet of spring honeysuckle, notes of lemongrass and white peaches. Lively and fresh on the palate with a nice roundness. Soft and spontaneous cuvée in its flexibility
